

East Contra Costa Irrigation District (ECCID) is a Groundwater Sustainability Agency in the East Contra Costa Subbasin.

The Sustainability Groundwater Management Act ("SGMA"), effective January 1, 2015, requires Groundwater Sustainability Agencies ("GSAs") in high and medium priority basins to develop and implement a Groundwater Sustainability Plan ("GSP"). The intent of SGMA is for groundwater to be managed by local public agencies and GSAs to ensure a groundwater basin is operated within its sustainable yield through the development and implementation of a GSP.

On April 20, 2017, the East Contra Costa Irrigation District (ECCID) became a GSA and on May 9, 2017 entered into a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") with seven other East Contra Costa GSAs to work together in the development of a GSP. ECCID groundwater is located in the newly designated "East Contra Costa Subbasin." The East Contra Costa Subbasin is designated a "medium-priority" basin.
